Note: Bidders are required to acknowledge this and all Addenda in Section 5(a) of the Bid Form.

This Addendum consists of the Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority's (CRRA) responses to written questions that were received by CRRA by 3:00 p.m., May 12, 2010, the deadline specified in the Instructions To Bidders for the submission of written questions.

1.	Question	It appears that 3/8" thick metal plates are much more readily available than 5/16" plates. Would CRRA consider changing the thickness specification for the metal plates from 5/16" to 3/8"?
	Answer	CRRA is hereby changing the thickness specification for the metal plates from 5/16" to 3/8".
2.	Question	Is there an estimated project value for the project?
	Answer	CRRA has chosen not to make public the amount budgeted for the project.
3.	Question	Who is the most recent supplier of the trommel screens to CRRA?
	Answer	The most recent supplier of the trommel screens is Welding Works, Inc.
4.	Question	Will the contractor be able to charge for waiting time if the trommels are not turned over at the allotted time?
	Answer	CRRA and the Waste Processing Facility ("WPF") Operator have made arrangements to ensure that the trommels are turned over at the allotted time. The contractor will not be able to charge for waiting time if the trommels are not turned over at the allotted time.
5.	Question	What are the provisions for repairs to trommel ribs if they are discovered?
	Answer	The contractor will be responsible for notifying the WPF Operator if any trommel ribs are found to need repair. The WPF Operator, not the contractor, will be responsible for making any necessary repairs.
6.	Question	What are the provisions if the contractor has to drill new holes in the trommel structure?
	Answer	The drilling of any new holes in the trommel structure is part of the Scope of Work for the project.
7.	Question	Will the trommels be available on Sundays for the work?
	Answer	CRRA does not guarantee that the trommels will be available on Sundays for the work, but CRRA will know by the preceding Thursday whether or not the trommels will be available on any particular Sunday.

8.	Question	How many trommel screens may be removed from any particular trommel at any one time?
	Answer	No more than two trommel screens may be removed from any particular trommel at any one time.
