1.	Question	Does the contractor have to be licensed in Connecticut to submit drawings?
	Answer	After consultation with staff from the CT Department of Consumer Protection who oversee licensing, CRRA is of the opinion that because the Trash Museum is a "place of public assembly," Proposers will have to have a Connecticut licensed architect place his or her seal on any plans or drawings we receive.
2.	Question	Exhibit B2 includes rough drawings of the existing site. Are there clearer examples of these (e.g. electronic file format).
	Answer	PDF copies of those drawings have been posted to the CRRA website as of February 3 rd , 2012.
3.	Question	Is there a designated budget for this project.
	Answer	The budget is still being finalized and will depend on responses to this RFP. It is expected that it will fall somewhere in a range between \$25,000 and \$65,000.
4.	Question	What is the area of the exhibit space in square feet?
	Answer	The exhibit space is approximately 530 square feet.
5.	Question	Is there a key to connect the student drawings in Exhibit B1 to the drawings in exhibit B2.
	Answer	<p>If you look at page 1 of exhibit B2:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The wall along the top edge of the page (that incorporates Section B and part of section A) would become the "Rethink" wall envisioned by the student on page 12 of Exhibit B1. • The wall along the left edge of the page (that extends from Section A down toward section C) would become the "Recycle" wall envisioned by the student on page 8 of Exhibit B1. • There is a wall that is off the scale of the drawing that would be along the bottom edge of the page (below section C) that would become the "Recovery" wall envisioned by the student on page 6 of exhibit B1. • Section C is actually the middle of the exhibit. On the right side of the exhibit is the scale area envisioned by the student at the "Reuse" area on p14. On the left side of the exhibit is the Recyclometer exhibit envisioned by the student on page 18 of exhibit B1.
