1. RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS

1.	Question	Who is currently providing ICW, tonnage commitment(s) and at what spot rate(s)?
	Answer	MIRA currently has existing tonnage commitments for ICW from two firms during fiscal year 2015 (July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015). The total tonnage commitment from these two firms is 60,000 tons. The rate for these existing tonnage commitments is \$54/ton and \$53.50/ton respectively.
2.	Question	Can deliveries be made at night?
	Answer	<p>The current hours of operation at the PBF are available at:</p> <p>http://www.crra.org/documents/tipping_regulations/holidays_CSWS_14.pdf</p> <p>In the past, MIRA has received temporary authorization from CT DEEP to accept deliveries of MSW on transfer trailers at night. However, these approvals were case-by-case, and for short durations. MIRA is in the process of seeking permanent authorization from CTDEEP to accept deliveries of transfer trailers at night, but currently does not have such authorization. Although MIRA believes that it will likely receive such authorization at some time in the future, MIRA cannot commit to accepting night deliveries at this time.</p>
