

## Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority Shelton Scholarship

Each year the Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority, in partnership with the Sports Center of Connecticut, will award a \$1,000 scholarship to a Shelton resident studying engineering or the sciences at an accredited four-year college. Preference will be given to applicants with declared majors in the environmental or energy fields.

To be eligible for the award, the recipient must be a Shelton resident and demonstrate

- academic achievement in high school and college;
- a record of community service; and
- an intention to pursue a career in environmental engineering, environmental science or another engineering or science discipline

The recipient will be selected by a committee of CRRA and Shelton representatives.

Applications are due August 1, 2004. A check will be presented to the recipient before the recipient completes the fall semester.
