## **Meghan Davis Receives CRRA Shelton Scholarship**

SHELTON, Conn. – Meghan Davis, a freshman at the University of Notre Dame in Notre Dame, Ind., has been awarded the 2010 CRRA Shelton Scholarship.

The \$1,000 CRRA Shelton Scholarship is awarded annually to one Shelton resident studying engineering or the sciences at an accredited four-year college. Preference is given to a student who declares a major in environmental or energy fields.

In her first semester at Notre Dame, Davis earned a 3.4 GPA (on a 4.0 scale). She graduated from Hopkins School in New Haven in 2009.

She plans to be a Business-Science major at Notre Dame and pursue a career in environmental education.

Outside of school, Davis's community service record includes serving as a peer tutor and volunteering with Habitat for Humanity, the Connecticut Food Bank and the Shelton Youth Soccer Organization.

The CRRA Shelton Scholarship is available through a special arrangement with the Sports Center of Connecticut (<http://www.SportsCenterCt.com>) located on River Road in Shelton.
