POSITION TITLE: Operations Engineer

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Manage the contracts and oversee operation of one or more CRRA waste-to-energy projects or other solid waste facilities including solid waste recycling centers and transfer stations. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: contract management, business negotiations, budget development, plant modifications, and performance and regulatory compliance monitoring for such projects and facilities.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Assemble, review and approve monthly invoices and assist with budgeting for CRRA's projects and facilities.
- Work with other members of Operations on various RFQs and RFPs, waste flow management, construction projects, and cost saving/revenue enhancing ideas.
- Manage Power Sales Agreements with local electric utility companies or other counterparties.
- Negotiate business and technical issues with contract operators, equipment vendors and other service providers.
- Review all capital budgets with respect to the facilities.
- Monitor and oversee the operation of various facilities, focusing on performance, cost, reliability and customer service.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE:

- 3-5 years experience in plant operations, preferably in a solid waste management program or facility.
- Experience in waste or other solid fuel fired power plants including boiler, turbine and air pollution control equipment and operations.

- Strong relationship management skills required.
- Solid understanding of contract management and contract negotiations process and its relation to solid waste management, utility support operations and energy related organizations.
- Bachelor’s degree in Engineering or a related field.
- Thorough knowledge of the principles, standard methods and practices of solid waste operations and facilities.
- Excellent communication and presentations skills.
- Ability to evaluate plans and designs of physical facilities relating to solid waste management.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to lift items or boxes generally weighing up to 40 pounds and infrequently weighing more than 40 pounds, if over 40lbs. a two-person lift may be required. Awkward or odd shaped heavy items should be handled with two people.
- Ability to sit and use a computer workstation, including keyboard and visual display terminal, for extended periods of time. Ability to stand for long periods of time.
- Position requires exposure to all weather conditions
- Ability to understand and follow directions and to communicate effectively with peers and supervisors
