

### **CRRA Garbage Museum Mixed Paper Recycling Flyer Contest** Rules

**Eligibility:** Students in Grade 4 – public and private schools

Theme: "Mixed Paper Recycling"

**Flyer** Flyer selected as the winner will be reproduced as a photograph. Therefore, try to keep the flyers simple

and easy to read. Copyrighted or trademarked characters cannot be used. Product brand names also should

not be used.

Size: 8 1/2 by 11 inches. Due to printing requirements, flyers not within these size specifications will be

ineligible for competition.

**Materials:** White copy paper, crayons, markers, colored pencils only.

**Policy of inclusion:** If these rules prevent a child with a disability from entering the contest, the teacher organizing the program

is authorized to alter the rules to the extent necessary to allow the child to participate. Also, the size

requirements can be waived if a child is unable to draw within the size restrictions. It is up to the organizing

teacher to determine how these rules should be applied.

**Judging:** Each participating school is to conduct a flyer contest and select one winner. Each school's winning flyer

should be submitted to:

attached to the back of the flyer.

Any flyer not having a release form completed and signed by both the student and parent will be ineligible

for the contest. A student's name should not appear on the front of the flyer.

Flyers will be judged based on correct information, content, ideas and creativity.

Each winner will also receive a "goody bag" of recycled paper products.

The winner will be invited to an awards ceremony to be held at The Garbage Museum during the week of

March 19-23, 2007.
