

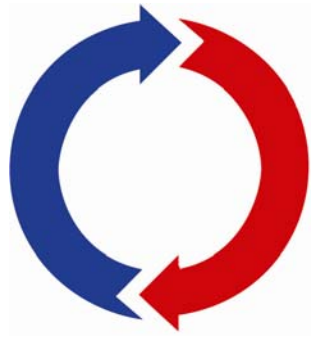

CRRA Garbage Museum Mixed Paper Recycling Flyer Contest Rules

- Eligibility:** Students in Grade 4 – public and private schools
- Theme:** “Mixed Paper Recycling”
- Flyer Requirements:** Flyer selected as the winner will be reproduced as a photograph. Therefore, try to keep the flyers simple and easy to read. Copyrighted or trademarked characters cannot be used. Product brand names also should not be used.
- Size:** 8 1/2 by 11 inches. Due to printing requirements, flyers not within these size specifications will be ineligible for competition.
- Materials:** White copy paper, crayons, markers, colored pencils only.
- Policy of inclusion:** If these rules prevent a child with a disability from entering the contest, the teacher organizing the program is authorized to alter the rules to the extent necessary to allow the child to participate. Also, the size requirements can be waived if a child is unable to draw within the size restrictions. It is up to the organizing teacher to determine how these rules should be applied.
- Deadline for Receipt of Entries:** February 15, 2007
- Judging:** Each participating school is to conduct a flyer contest and select one winner. Each school’s winning flyer should be submitted to:

- The winning flyer **must be accompanied by the release form. The release form should be securely attached to the back of the flyer.**
Any flyer not having a release form completed and signed by both the student and parent will be ineligible for the contest. **A student’s name should not appear on the front of the flyer.**
- Flyers will be judged based on correct information, content, ideas and creativity.

Mixed paper includes the following:

- newspapers
- magazines
- catalogs
- paper envelopes (punch out glassine window inserts)
- home computer printer paper
- shredded office paper
- bills and bill inserts
- coupons
- stationery

Not acceptable:

- plastic bags or wrapping paper
- books of any kind
- overnight express envelopes
- soap boxes
- bubble wrap
- greeting cards
- gift wrap
- products or samples sent through the mail

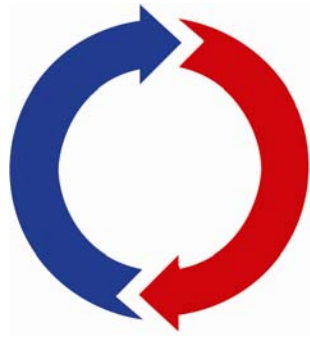

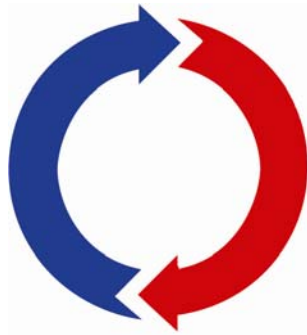

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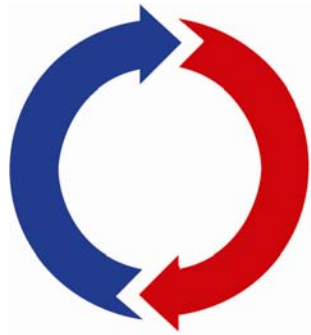
