



POLICY GUIDELINES FOR ACCEPTING RESIDUE FROM RECYCLING FACILITIES

BOARD OF DIRECTORS POLICY AND PROCEDURE NO. BOD 040

Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority (CRRA) Projects will accept residue from recycling facilities, as defined in P.A. 89-386 (CGS 22a-207), that meet all of the following conditions:

- (1) The Recycling Facility must possess a valid Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Permit to Operate a Recycling Facility. A DEP permitted Solid Waste Facility (other than Recycling Facility) which provides for recycling in its approved Plan of Operations may also be deemed to be eligible by CRRA project staff for this purpose. A copy of the DEP Permit to operate must be provided to CRRA. Compliance with eligibility criteria must be determined by CRRA prior to acceptance of residue.
- (2) Residue will only be accepted in direct proportion to the solid waste received and processed by the Recycling Facility from Project Member towns or other CRRA approved towns (i.e., if a facility accepts 100 tons of solid waste and 10 tons of this is from project towns, CRRA will accept 10% of the total recycling residue).
- (3) CRRA reserves the right to impose limits on the total amount of residue received from a facility.
- (4) A listing by Town of the amount of solid waste received, the total amount of residue generated, the amount of residue apportioned to each municipality, the method used to calculate the amount apportioned to each municipality, and the location at which all residue was disposed shall be submitted to CRRA with each payment for the period covered by the payment.
- (5) The recycling facility generating the residue will be responsible for payment of all tipping fees.

- (6) All vehicles delivering residue must possess a current, valid CRRA permit, including but not limited to the necessary payment guarantees, proof of insurance and indemnification agreements.
- (7) CRRA Projects from time to time may allow the receipt and disposal of processible non-project residue on a spot basis.
- (8) CRRA reserves the right to inspect any facility, including records of solid waste and residue, from which residue disposal is requested and/or received.
- (9) Categories of residue and tipping fees for FY 90-91 are as follows:

CATEGORY	TIPPING FEE
A. Residue from CRRA sponsored Recycling Centers	Project MSW rate or rate established by contract with recycling facility vendor(s)
B. Residue from Project Communities (processible)	Project MSW rate + \$5/ton
C. Residue from Project Communities (landfill)	Project Commercial Bulky Waste rate + \$5/ton
D. Residue from Non-Project (spot) towns (processible only)	\$70/ton
